MacPhee Banking Leadership Scholarship will cover tuition to one or more designated education events through the CBM, the ICBA and/or The Barret School of Banking Graduate School. The scholarships listed below are available for 2024

[] Barret Graduate School of Banking – tuition & lodging covered for all 3 years of the school

The Barret Graduate School of Banking is a three-year graduate school that includes an annual one-week residency session. The 2024 session will be held **May 19 – 24, 2024**, at the Paul W. Barret, Jr. School of Banking in Memphis, TN. The Barret Graduate School of Banking is endorsed by the CBM and the ICBA.

[] ICBA Capital Summit – registration and travel reimbursement (up to \$1000)

Join community bankers from around the country as they gather in Washington, D.C. to meet with legislators and discuss issues critical to the future of community banking. The ICBA Capital Summit will be **April 28 – May 1, 2024.**
