Check Fraud – A National Pandemic Webinar

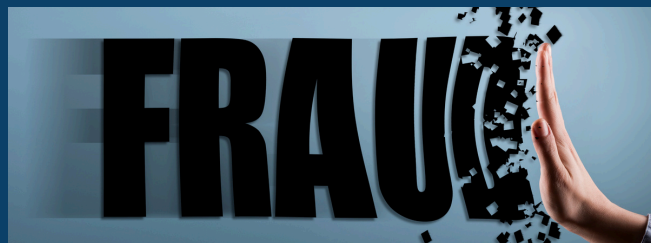
